Evaluative College Admissions Interview Questions

Introduction

General Questions

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Academic and Extracurricular Questions

 - How do you manage your time between academics and extracurricular activities?
 - What extracurricular activity has been most meaningful to you?
 - Tell me about a leadership role you have held.
 - How have you contributed to your school or community?
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College Fit and Motivation

- What do you hope to gain from your college experience?
 - How do you see yourself contributing to our campus community?
 - What makes our college/university a good fit for you?
 - Are there any specific programs, clubs, or organizations you are interested in joining here?
 - What are your career goals, and how will our college help you achieve them?
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Personal Reflection and Growth

- Describe a time you faced a significant challenge or failure. How did you handle it?
- Tell me about a time you worked as part of a team.
- What is something you are passionate about outside of academics?

- How have you grown or changed during high school?
 - What accomplishment are you most proud of?
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Current Events and Critical Thinking

- What is a recent news story that caught your attention? Why?
 - If you could change one thing about your school or community, what would it be and why?
 - Who is someone you admire and why?
 - How do you handle disagreements with others?
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Closing Questions

- Is there anything else you would like us to know about you?
 - Do you have any questions for me about the college or the admissions process?
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Tips for Success

- Practice answering these questions out loud.
 - Be honest and authentic in your responses.
 - Use specific examples to illustrate your points.
 - Research the college beforehand to tailor your answers.
 - Prepare thoughtful questions to ask the interviewer.
